With all the troubles in Myanmar, our building projects are needed more than ever! In 2017, your support enabled Myanmar/Burma Schools Project Foundation to construct seven new schools and four new teachers' cottages in rural villages in Myanmar. The CRA Charities Directorate has granted us permission to also build rural medical clinics and we built a fine new one in Myin Htaik village. With your help for 2018 projects, we will continue the work of building schools and medical clinics for the impoverished rural villagers of Myanmar.

Roger Brain and Steve Armstrong have just returned from the annual MBSPF schools trip where they saw all the new 2017 buildings and scouted locations for 2018 projects.

In **They Phyu Chung** village, for example, they were very happy to see the old school and teacher housing replaced with fine new buildings:



As always, the local villagers have been tremendously helpful with the construction process this year. These photos show **Ye Twin Kaung** villagers hard at work on their new school construction and the end results:



In 2018, we plan to replace old bamboo classrooms like these ones in **Than Nu Taw** and **Ku Toe Sade** with new school buildings in seven villages:
